While all around me a voice was sounding

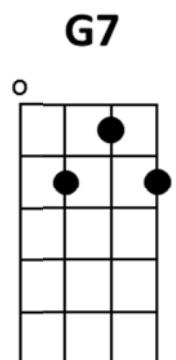
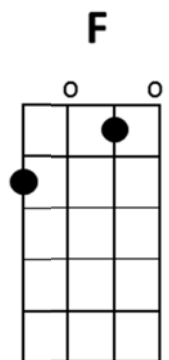
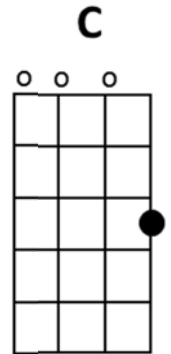

This land was made for you and me.



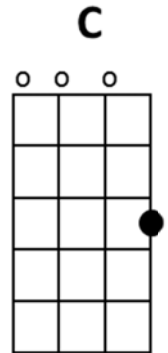

That side was made for you and me.

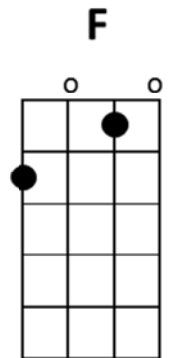
