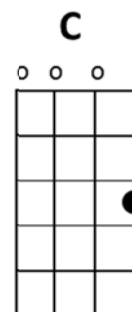


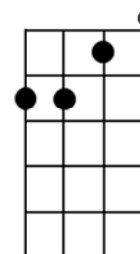
FOUR STRONG WINDS 4/4 100 BPM

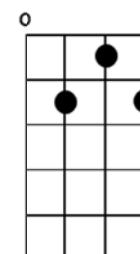

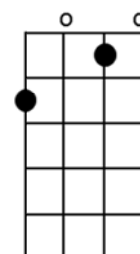

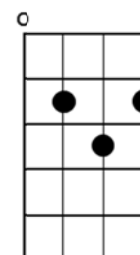
